The Pennsylvania Project

The proposed Pennsylvania High-Speed Maglev Project is a high-speed magnetic levitation transportation system that extends from Pittsburgh International Airport to the Greensburg area with MAGport™ Stations located at the Airport, downtown Pittsburgh, Monroeville and in the Greensburg area. The system, which is approximately 50 miles in length, would take passengers from the Greensburg area to the Airport in approximately 30 minutes.

The Pennsylvania High-Speed Maglev Project is a public/private partnership between Port Authority of Allegheny County, MAGLEV, Inc., and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation in cooperation with the Federal Railroad Administration.

Municipalities that could potentially be affected by Maglev construction include:

Findlay Township; Moon Township; Robinson Township; Kennedy Township; McKees Rocks Borough; City of Pittsburgh (Esplan, Strip District, Downtown, Lawrenceville); Municipality of Penn Hills; Verona Borough; Oakmont Borough; Plum Borough; Municipality of Monroeville; Municipality of Murrysville;
